We will have it open when we dig the sweet potatoes the last of October. Last year at this time we had harvested 4,305 pounds including 3,168 pounds of tomatoes. The grasshoppers have gotten their share this year.



October! Time of pumpkins and Halloween fun. My dessert this month can use up some of your leftover Halloween candy-miniature peanut butter cups to be exact. But there is a warning with these treats. THEY ARE ADDICTIVE! But I'm getting ahead of myself. I found a chicken and mushroom recipe in some book and this was the second time making it and I liked it even better this time. Hope you enjoy it too.

Baked Chicken and Mushrooms

24 ounces of chicken breast – I just used two chicken breasts, pounded them a little with a meat mallet and then cut them in half so I had four pieces.

½ cup flour with ½ teaspoon paprika whisked into it

Dredge the chicken in the flour mixture, then heat **3 tablespoons butter** and **2 tablespoons oil** in a skillet and cook the chicken about 15 minutes.

Place cooked chicken in a 9x9 pan and sprinkle with more paprika.

In skillet, melt another 2 tablespoons of butter and put 8 ounces of sliced fresh mushrooms in the butter and sauté for 5 minutes.

Add ½ cup chicken broth, 5 green onions, chopped, 1 clove garlic, minced, ½ teaspoon salt and ¼ teaspoon pepper. Bring to a boil, then pour over chicken. Bake in 350 degree oven until chicken measures 165 degrees on a meat thermometer, about 15 minutes. Top with ¾ cup to 1 cup mozzarella cheese and put bake in oven for 3-5 minutes or until cheese melts. I served this with petite gold potatoes and onions fried in the same skillet I cooked the chicken and broth in.

Now for the yummy treats that are SO addictive! Here is another recipe that uses my miniature muffin tin. I hope you have purchased one by now.

Miniature Peanut Butter Treats

½ cup butter, softened ½ teaspoon vanilla

½ cup brown sugar, packed 1 ¼ cup flour

½ cup granulated sugar ¾ teaspoon baking soda

1 egg ½ teaspoon salt

½ cup creamy peanut butter 36 miniature peanut butter cups, unwrapped

Combine butter, sugars, egg, peanut butter, and vanilla in mixing bowl; beat until smooth. Combine flour, soda, and salt; add to creamed mixture. Roll into small balls and place each in miniature muffin tin.

With thumb dipped in sugar, make a well or depression in each cookie. Bake at 375 degree oven for 8 minutes.

Remove from oven and immediately place 1 peanut butter cup in each. Cool in pan for 10 minutes. Twist gently to remove from pan. Cool on rack. Store in cool place until serving time.

Place any remaining (there won't be) into air tight container.
